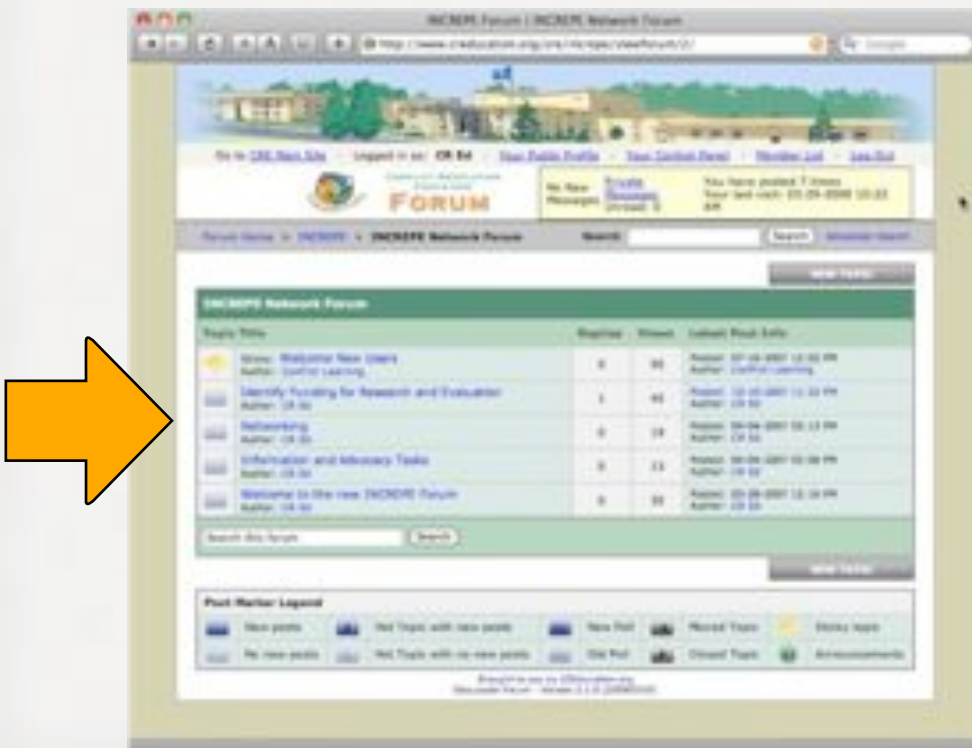

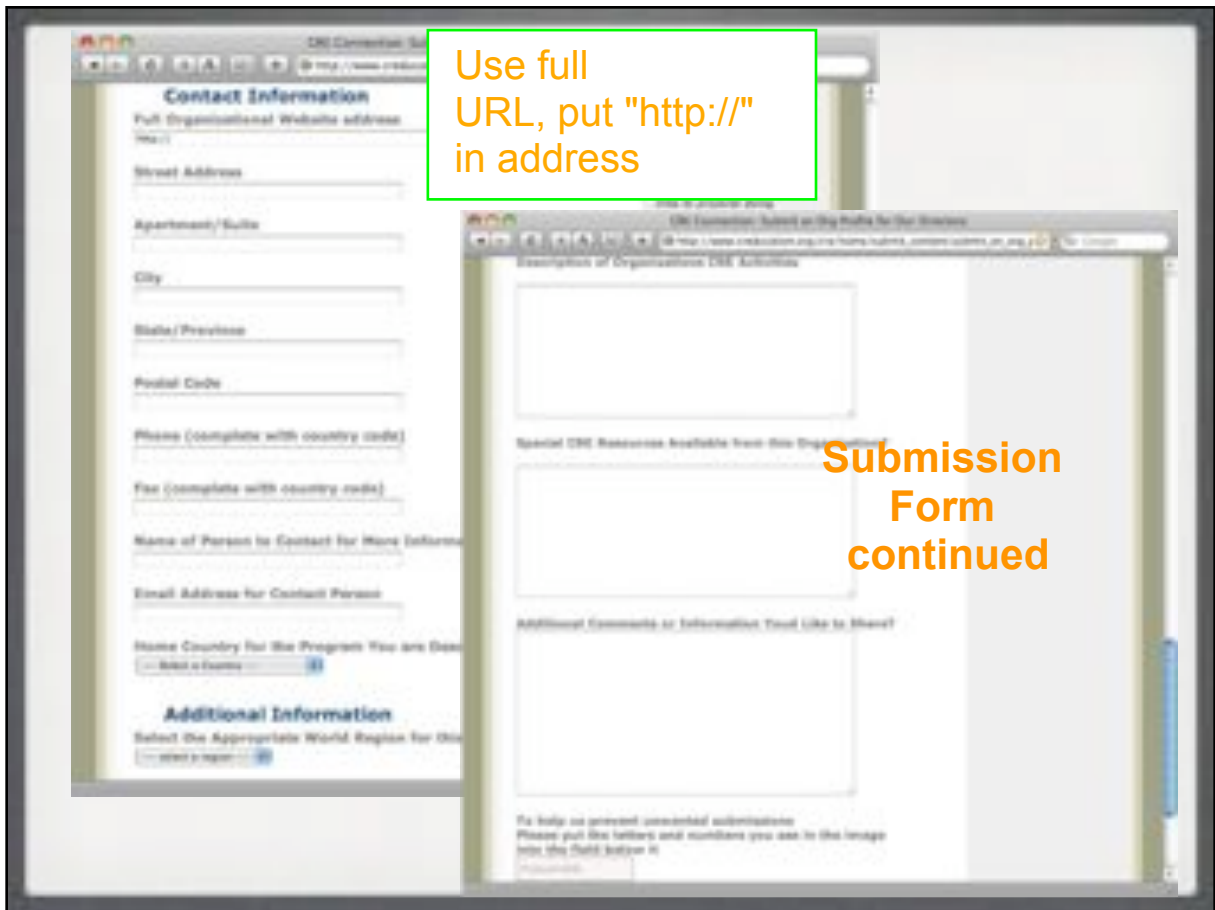
Our Catalog is Shared Worldwide OAlster.org is an Example
