12 noon: Moment of Silence by the fountain

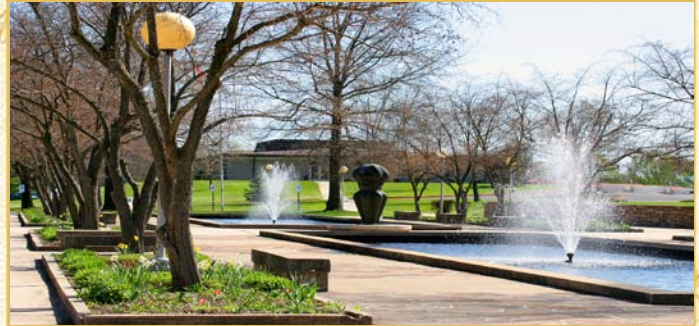
12:30 pm – 1:30 pm: Activities of relaxation and meditation in the Green Room
